**PENTECOST- KATAKLYSMOS (Flood Festival-
DELUGE)**

“Kataklysmos” is a religious and popular feast celebrated only in Cyprus. “Kataklysmos”, which means flood, is found in the book of Genesis and in the Greek myth of Deukalion. In both cases it refers to the destruction by flood of almost all-living creatures in order to give birth to a new and moral generation. The ceremonies last for a few days and take place in all sea side towns. Celebrations include various games, performances of folk dances, swimming competitions, boat races, competitions of popular songs known as “tsattista” and the most popular custom, which is the throwing of water to one another. This symbolises the purification of the body and soul.

Celebrating 50 Years of the Loukia & Michael Zampelas Collection

As part of the 50th anniversary celebration, parallel exhibitions and events will take place until July 29, 2016.
