CYPRUS RE-OPENS ITS BORDERS TO VISITORS FROM GEORGIA

NICOSIA, CYPRUS, March 26th, 2021 - Taking all necessary measures to ensure that visitors enjoy their holidays in a safe and carefree environment, Cyprus will be opening its borders to all visitors from Georgia, as follows:

<u>Opening of Borders</u>: Cyprus opens its borders to all visitors from Georgia as of **April 1st, 2021.**

<u>Quarantine-free Travel</u>: All tested and proved to be covid-free passengers who have not come into close contact with a confirmed case, will be guaranteed a quarantine-free stay.

<u>Travelling with Children</u>: Children under the age of 12 are not required to undergo any testing. Children aged 12-18 will still be required to undergo testing as per the enforced Protocol.

<u>Protocol</u>: Travellers are required to follow all regulations, measures and precautions as described in the <u>Cyprus Destination Protocol</u>.
