Boat trip to Agia Napa / Bike tour Cape Greko Daily Package

Technical Details

- **Total distance: 16km**
- **Difficulty: Low with some short hilly sections**
- **Road Surface: Asphalt with sections of cycle path**
- **Bike to be used: Trekking or MTB**
- **Traffic: This route is mainly on cycle paths and low traffic roads.**

- **Daily Schedule:**

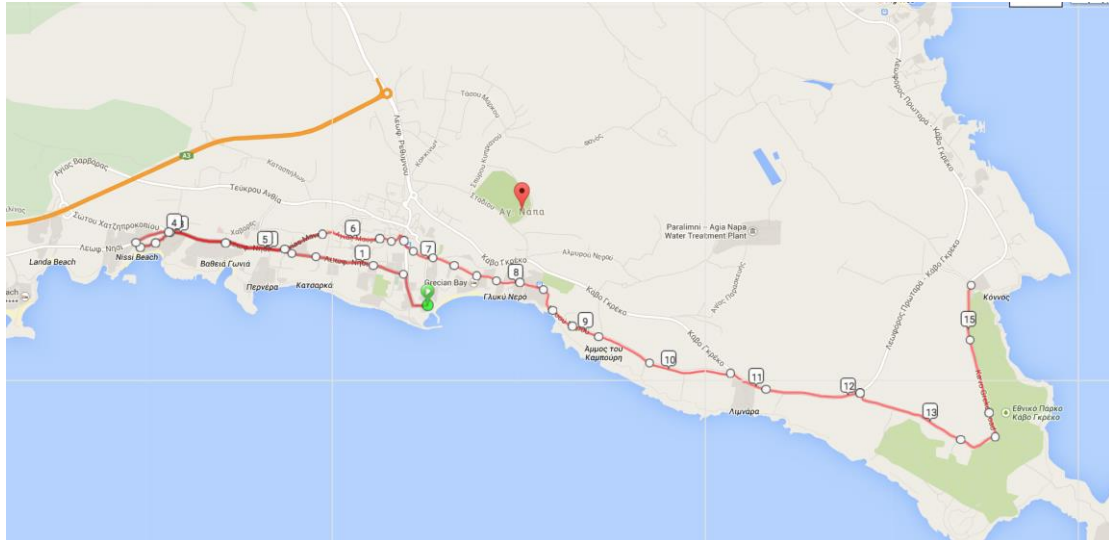
The meeting point for the first day of the tour is the Larnaca Marina from where we sail to Agia Napa. There we get off the boat to start our riding through Agia Napa to Cape Greko. In Agia Napa we visit the Monastery in the center of the village and the Thalassa Museum. The tour ends in Cape Greko, one of the most scenic coastlines in the island. We have lunch in the area. After lunch we return by bus to Larnaka Marina.



This package connects to EuroVelo 8 – Mediterranean Route, a long distance cycle route that passes through eleven European countries from Spain to Cyprus. The route forms part of EuroVelo, the European cycle route network. EuroVelo 8 is expected to be realised in 2020 by which time it will total 6,000 km. Hundreds of kilometres are already in place waiting to be explored. More information is available from EuroVelo.com.
