SACRED CEREMONIES

Every wedding is as unique as the two hearts it will unite, and Cyprus offers a range of different and beautifully bespoke options that reflect your devotion, including civil ceremonies/partnerships, church marriages, religious blessings and vow renewals.

Religious ceremonies and blessings can take place in churches, chapels or other places of worship across the island. Many hotels also have their own private chapels – often overlooking the beach or sea. Couples must first apply for a Marriage License at the Municipal Offices before making the necessary arrangements for a religious ceremony or blessing with a registered Minister of the religion of their choice.



CEREMONIES, BLESSINGS AND UNIONS





Civil unions can take place directly at the Municipal Offices where the Marriage License is obtained, or in a myriad of other settings by securing permission. Options include the classic backdrop of sand and sea; on public or hotel beaches, piers, harbours and yachts. More unusual or historic options are also available, in-

cluding traditional buildings; gardens and golf courses; ancient ruins and castles; wineries, galleries and museums – or any other location that is desired with the appropriate arrangements, for which the Municipal Offices or a professional Wedding Coordinator can assist with.

PICTURE-PERFECT

The seductive scenery of Cyprus is magnificently made for memorable wedding photography that can be woven into the big day - without the need for a separate studio session.

The island's stunning, natural beauty spots inspire photo opportunities in abundance. Sand and Sea

An island encompassed by golden sands and clear, blue sea is naturally one that offers all the pleasures of the coast. Cyprus has a high number of awarded Blue Flag organised beaches. These offer a range of conveniences and facilities, such as sun loungers and parasols, WC, showers and changing rooms, lifeguard towers, disabled facilities, water sports, sand playgrounds and kiosks of food, drink and essential supplies.

With ideal sea temperatures and an absence of

dangerous marine life, one of the top activities to enjoy in the water is diving, and the island is home to many fantastic dive sites and artificial reefs, including the Zenobia wreck – one of the world's top five wreck dives.

Other sea sports can also be mastered, including kitesurfing, SUP, jet skiing, paragliding, sailing, yachting, fishing and rides on fun inflatables. For those who prefer to enjoy the water without getting wet, there is no shortage of boat rides and themed cruises that are offered as short, half-day, full-day or evening options.

Gastronomy

The Mediterranean Diet is considered to be one of the healthiest and is simply bursting with fresh produce and full flavours. The local cuisine typically incorporates olive oil, pulses and legumes, local cheeses, cured and stewed meats, seafood, village breads, Cypriot potatoes, grains such as buckwheat, fresh salad vegetables, seasonal fruits and sticky desserts.

For a real taste of Cyprus, the traditional taverns where the famous 'meze' meal is served are always a winning bet. Comprised of many, small dishes the meze is perfect for sharing and for trying out the different local specialties. Or, why not try the well-balanced and nutritious 'Cyprus Breakfast'? For the freshest fish, the harbours are the place to head for. Here the morning's catch of the day is served in quaint restaurants overlooking the peaceful, bobbing fishing boats.

Other than the local cuisine, the island offers an enormous selection of international and fusion dining options. Elegant, award-winning fine cuisine can be savoured amidst glamour and glitz, and casual or quick dining is served in modern cafes and quirky bistros with many popular, international franchises also available.

Viticulture

As the home of Commandaria – the world's oldest named wine still in production – Cyprus has a longstanding love affair with viticulture. Oenophiles and wine enthusiasts will delight in discovering the history, grape varieties and vintages of the island in the most picturesque surroundings of the rural vineyards.

The winemaking industry is primarily centred in the mountain communities of the Lemesos (Limassol) district. Here, the villages continue the tradition with passion and pride and jointly celebrate this shared heritage with annual festivals where their winemaking is presented to much merriment.



Aside from the winemaking villages, there are a series of wineries that meander through quaint countryside and range from the more largescale to boutique and family-owned. Most openly welcome visitors to their premises and will offer guided tours of the harvest and winemaking process, as well as a tasting of their unique, select vintages.

A network of self-guided, signposted wine routes created by The Deputy Ministry of Tourism make for a great day out and is easy and interesting to follow. The routes travel from the high, sun-kissed southern slopes of the Troodos mountain range, to a stunning stretch of valleys between Lemesos (Limassol) and Pafos, and the rural areas of Larnaka and Lefkosia (Nicosia), with quaint villages, wineries and wine museums to discover along the way.

Traditional Experiences

Cyprus is steeped in tradition and many of its authentic pastimes are still practised to this day and safeguarded with their inclusion on the UNESCO List of Intangible Cultural Heritage, including that of homemade food and handmade folkloric crafts.

Traditional pastimes include iconography, woodworking, basketry, silversmithing, lace making, pottery, copper and iron works... and more. The rural and mountainous villages typically each practise their own distinctive traditions with locals happy to showcase their skills at their workshops; often offering the opportunity for a hands-on experience.

Culinary traditions include the handmaking of local delicacies using original methods and

family recipes passed down for generations. Some of the most popular products are local cheeses like Halloumi and Anari; cured meats infused with wine and spices; crusty village bread and rusks; delectable treats made of carob and grape; preserved spoon sweets from local fruit, vegetables, peel and rind; sugar-powdered Cyprus delights with a romantic link to Goddess Aphrodite, and many more enticing products made with love and heritage. Organised cooking demonstrations and work-



shops are also available.

Authentic food-themed activities can be experienced with the tasty reward of enjoying the fruits of your labour at the end of the day. The cluster of beekeeping and honey producing villages offer beekeeping and honey making/ bottling excursions and tours in the mountains, where foraging for wild herbs and edibles is also available. Many orchards and estates welcome visitors to get stuck in during harvest time; picking or collecting grapes, almonds, carobs, olives and other locally-grown produce, surrounded by nature's finest canvas.

History and Culture

With over 11,000 years of rich history, Cyprus is a vibrant time-capsule of sites, monuments and museums, where ancient stories of the many different civilisations that passed through the island can be felt. The Antiquities Department carefully maintains castles, mosaics, ruins, Venetian bridges, sites of worship, and other significant sites that are open to the general public, whilst professional tourist guides are available for a more in-depth look into the past.

A series of self-guided cultural routes has been created by the Deputy Tourism of Ministry encompassing wine, religion and history, as well as downloadable audio guides for some of the island's most significant landmarks.

A year-round cultural calendar of music, theatre, dance, exhibitions and themed festivals by local performers and international touring troupes ensures that there is always something interesting to see or watch. The island is also home to many national, European and international competitions and festivals of the arts, attracting artists and performers from all over the world. The event diaries of the local tourism boards are continually updated on all the exciting happenings taking place in each region.
